



Itinerary 3: Pont Neuf, Seine Cruise & Paris Highlights Walk

This route is perfect if you want to see Pont Neuf and central Paris from two perspectives: first on foot, then from the water.



1 **Start at Pont Neuf Metro Station**
Arrive at Pont Neuf metro station on Line 7 and walk toward the bridge. This is the easiest way to avoid confusion around Pont Neuf traffic restrictions, road closure areas, or bus diversions.



2 **Visit La Caverne du Pont Neuf**
Spend time around La Caverne du Pont Neuf by JR. This is the main reason to choose this route. During the event, Pont Neuf does not feel like an ordinary bridge. It becomes a temporary Paris experience, combining contemporary art, public space, history, and architecture.



3 **Add a Seine Cruise from Vedettes du Pont Neuf**
After seeing the installation on foot, add a Seine cruise from Vedettes du Pont Neuf if available and convenient for your schedule. From the water, you can enjoy bridges, riverbanks, monuments, and Paris architecture from a completely different angle.
Before going, check the official cruise schedule and access information because the Pont Neuf area may be busier than usual during the event.



4 **Walk to Quai du Louvre for Photos**
After the cruise, walk toward Quai du Louvre for more photos. This is a good place to capture the Seine, the bridge area, the Louvre side, and the movement of central Paris.



5 **Choose Your Ending: Louvre or La Samaritaine**
Option A: Louvre Courtyard — choose this if you want iconic Paris photos and a classic cultural ending.
Option B: La Samaritaine — choose this if you want shopping, coffee, toilets, a comfort stop, or a more relaxed finish.
Either option works well. The route stays central, simple, and easy to follow.
