

# Itinerary 1: Classic Pont Neuf, Louvre & Seine Walk

*This is the best route if you want a simple half-day walk around Pont Neuf, the Louvre, and the Seine without making the day too complicated. It is easy to follow, beautiful for photos, and ideal for tourists who want a real Paris experience in a short time.*

## Start at Pont Neuf Metro Station, Line 7

Begin at Pont Neuf metro station on Line 7. This is the easiest starting point because it brings you close to the bridge, the Seine, La Samaritaine, and La Caverne du Pont Neuf.

★ *Tourist tip: arrive in the morning or late afternoon for better light and fewer crowds.*

## Visit La Caverne du Pont Neuf by JR

Walk toward Pont Neuf and take your time around La Caverne du Pont Neuf by JR. This is the main attraction of the route and a special open-air artwork in the heart of historic Paris.

## Rest at Square du Vert-Galant

After visiting the installation, walk down to Square du Vert-Galant, the small garden at the western tip of Île de la Cité. It is a peaceful place to pause, take Seine photos, sit for a few minutes, or let children rest.

## Walk Along Quai du Louvre

Continue toward Quai du Louvre for beautiful views of the Seine, Paris architecture, passing boats, and nearby bridges. Some of the best Paris photos are taken from the riverbanks nearby.

## Finish at the Louvre Courtyard

End the walk at the Louvre Courtyard. Even without visiting the museum, the palace architecture, glass pyramid, and surrounding area make this one of the best photo stops in central Paris.



*Take your time, enjoy the view, and soak in the Paris atmosphere.*



### RONELJAKE Souvenir Tip

After this walk, choose something small, useful, and easy to carry, such as a Paris keychain, fridge magnet, compact wallet, purse, lightweight bag, postcard, or Eiffel Tower souvenir. A good souvenir should remind you of a real Paris moment.



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
